Dai-ichi Life Insurance Myanmar Ltd. (Dai-ichi Life Myanmar), which is a wholly owned subsidiary of The Dai-ichi Life Insurance Company, Limited (the "Company"; President and Representative Director: Seiji Inagaki) in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar (Myanmar), commenced operations on September 15, 2020.

Dai-ichi Life Myanmar officially obtained a license by the then MoPF (current MoPFI) to carry out life insurance business in Myanmar on November 28, 2019 and since then Dai-ichi Life Myanmar had been preparing for full-scale life insurance business in Myanmar in cooperation with DLI Asia Pacific Pte. Ltd., an area management company in Singapore, and the group companies in Southeast Asia.

In Myanmar, where sustainable economic growth is expected due to its large population, the Company will provide long term security through life insurance and contribute to people's prosperous living and the development of local communities through Dai-ichi Life Myanmar. Moving forward, Dai-ichi Life Group will continue to pursue sustainable value by fully utilizing its global trilateral structure which includes Japan, North America and Asia Pacific.
